Electrical service offered is for 1 (one) plug-in connection of 15 amp service.

There are just a few spaces with 40 amp electrical service available.

Please note: 15 amps of service WILL NOT power several appliances; especially hot plates, fryers, etc.

Vendors needing more than 15 amps of electrical service are encouraged to provide their own.

Please advise us if you are bringing your own generator.

Food Vendors MUST remove all cooking oil and food refuse from the site. We do not provide disposal of oil.

***You must pay for booth and services in advance unless special arrangements are made.***

PLEASE DO NOT PARK ALONG SULLIVAN STREET  
UNTIL YOU KNOW YOUR SPACE NUMBER AND SET UP TIME.

Bullion Plaza is at the west end of Sullivan Street.

You will be shown to your booth and you will have ½ hour to drop off your items (you will have ample space beside your booth) then you **MUST** move your vehicle and return to setup. **If you will need help to unload please let us know as soon as possible.**

**1 day booth set-up:** please check in at Boomtown Spree information booth - located at the NW corner of Sullivan & Keystone between 7 am & 8 am

*You may close or restock your booths at any time however*

**NO VEHICLES** will be allowed on Sullivan Street from 5:30 pm to 9:30 pm on Friday, from 8:30 am to 9 pm on Saturday and from 8:30 am to 5 pm on Sunday.

*Booth size is 14' deep and 15' long.*

*You set up on a paved street so PLEASE do not use stakes.*

*Your booth is along the curb, facing the street, you can have both open if you choose.*

*You must provide your own tables, chairs and canopies as needed.*

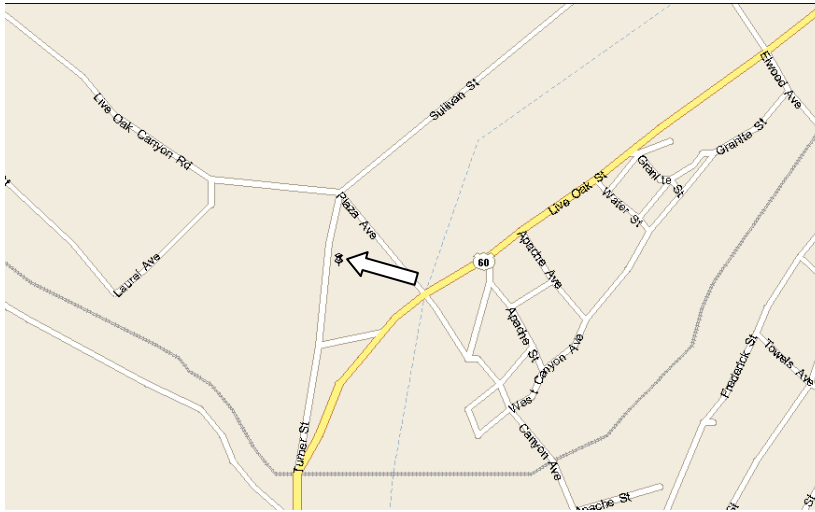
*No items (including signs) are allowed on the sidewalks or in the street outside of your booth.*

*If you purchased electricity YOU are responsible for providing your own power strip and cord. ONLY 1 plug will be available per vendor. You will be told where to plug in when you check in.*

*There is a limited amount of water available at the park but you will have to haul it, no hoses allowed.*

*Do not dispose of cooking oils at the site and do not leave it behind.*

*Safety is our first concern and your cooperation is greatly appreciated.*



Bullion Plaza Museum is located North off hwy 60 at the west end of Miami – make the first left turn when traveling East on hwy 60 after you come into town.

Look for the BIG yellow haul truck & truck bed display on hwy 60 at Bullion Plaza.

Line up between the display plaza and the school building.

Check-in at the front steps of the old school building.

### **FOOD or BEVERAGE VENDORS**

*YOU MUST contact the Gila County Health Department at 928-425-3231 for 3 single DAY PERMITS or an ANNUAL PERMIT. There will be an INSPECTION by the County Health Department.*

*You MUST HAVE at least ONE (1) FIRE EXTINGUISHER with a rating of 2A10BC.*

*Please do NOT dispose of waste or wash water in the street, park or wash.*

*You must dispose of all forms of cooking oil and cleaning products properly – DO NOT leave them behind or put them in the town garbage cans – you MUST take them with you. Garbage other than oil may be taken to the dumpster we will have off site for the event.*

The Miami Boomtown Spree Association will have the authority to stipulate what kinds of products and/or services are available for sale, and can require any vendor to eliminate a product or service if just cause is found that the product, service, etc. is causing a distraction to the event or a safety hazard to the public.
